




## **Guide: Campus 3.0**

This guide provides an introduction to Campus 3.0.



1. At the top, you will find a navigation bar with the following buttons:



- 2. **ME** gives you access to an overview of your own activities in Campus.
  - a. Under "ME" you will find "My plan" with an overview of your own courses, goals/development plans, reviews, etc.

## 3. GROUPS

a. Under "Groups Home" you will see the groups you are a member of. For example, a group may be created in connection with a course for sharing information or group work.




## 4. WORKSPACES


- a. Under "Workspaces" you will find all the workspaces that are shared with you. For example, this could be the workspace "Help for Campus."
- 5. **HELP FOR CAMPUS** is a workspace where you can find information about the various types of support available to you as a Campus user.
- 6. On the left side of the screen, just below the navigation bar, you will find a shortcut to the **CATALOG**.



By clicking here, you will enter the catalog, where you can find all courses in Campus, divided into 11 overall categories.



If you access one of the 11 overall categories, you will be taken directly to that category and its related courses.





7. If you know the topic or the name of the course you are looking for, you can use the **Search field** located just below the image.




8. You can also get inspiration from the courses recommended under the heading Courses recommended by Campus.


These courses are regularly updated and selected by the Campus team. For example, selected cybersecurity courses may be featured during **Cybersecurity Month** in October.



9. Under the heading My Learning, you can see the courses you are currently working on.




10. On the far right, you will find a box labeled Current news.




If you click the link "**Show all current news**" you will be taken to an overview of all current news. Here, you can see more information about the current news item as well as browse all previous news posts.





11. On the far right, you will also find a box labeled **Employee development**. Here you will find shortcuts to the three areas under Employee Development. These shortcuts lead to the same elements that you can also access via "Me" in the navigation bar.

**Note:** This box will only be visible if your institution uses one or more of these Employee Development elements. If your institution uses only some of them, only those links will appear in the box.



12. On the far right, you will also find a box labeled **My Groups**. Here, you will find shortcuts to the groups you are a member of.

If you want to view a different overview of all the groups you belong to, you can also access **Groups** via the navigation bar at the top.
